Since 2000 the AAUW Laguna Beach Foundation (AAUW-LBF), the nonprofit arm of AAUW Laguna Beach Branch, has raised funds to support community programs. - **Applicants must agree to submit an evaluative report documenting outcomes achieved through this funding by April 1, 2010**
